Submit changes online at: www.VoteWA.gov, or by mail to PO Box 400, Shelton, WA 98584 – must be received by the Auditor's Office by Monday, October 26, 2020.

After Monday, October 26, 2020, all voter registration applications or updates must be presented in-person, at our Voting Center and will be processed until 8:00 p.m. on Election Night. We are located at 411 N 5th St, Shelton, WA 98584. Please note, due to the changing nature of the COVID-19 pandemic, we ask that you visit us at www.masoncountyelections.us for current precautions and procedures.
