The Mason County Auditor's Office has voter registration aids to assist elderly or disabled persons available during regular business hours, Monday – Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Additionally, accessible voting equipment is available during business hours in the voting period, January 24 – February 11 and on Election Day February 11, 2020 9:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

The voting equipment is available to any voter who wishes to use it, but the equipment has special features to allow voters with disabilities to vote independently.
