Submit changes online at: www.VoteWA.gov, or by mail to PO Box 400, Shelton, WA 98584 – must be received by the Auditor's Office by Monday, April 28, 2020.

After Monday, April 20, 2020, all voter registration applications or updates must be presented in-person, at the Mason County Auditor's Office, and will be processed until 8:00 p.m. on Election Night. We are located at 411 N 5th St, Shelton, WA 98584. Please note that because of the COVID-19 emergency we will be offering limited hours and modified procedures please call (360) 427-9670 ext. 466 to determine our availability.
