All mail and online voter registration applications or updates must be received by Monday, July 27, 2020 to be effective for the August 4, 2020, Primary Election. Submit changes online at: [www.VoteWA.gov](http://www.VoteWA.gov), or by mail to PO Box 400, Shelton, WA 98584 – must be received by the Auditor's Office by Monday, July 27, 2020.

After Monday, July 27, 2020, all voter registration applications or updates must be presented in-person, at our Voting Center and will be processed until 8:00 p.m. on Election Night. We are located at 411 N 5th St, Shelton, WA 98584. Please note, due to the changing nature of the COVID-19 pandemic, we ask that you visit us at [www.masoncountyelections.us](http://www.masoncountyelections.us) for current precautions and procedures.
