All mail and online voter registration applications or updates must be received by Monday, February 1, 2021 to be effective for the February 9, 2021 Special Election. Submit changes online at: www.VoteWA.gov, or by mail to PO Box 400, Shelton, WA 98584 – must be received by the Auditor's Office by Monday, February 1, 2021.

After Monday, February 1, 2021, all voter registration applications or updates must be presented in-person, at our Vote Center and will be processed until 8:00 p.m. on Election Night. We are located at 411 N 5th St, Shelton, WA 98584.
